Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (STRO11679) affecting the C205 Station Road at its intersection with the level crossing for 10m westwards and 10m eastwards (the "Road") in the Parish of Burston and Shimpling to facilitate Network Rail track maintenance, the Road will be temporarily closed (except for pedestrian access) for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be from 11<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> January 2025 only whilst signs indicate closures are in place, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2025 where the closure is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

Alternative route is via: Station Road, Burston Road, Dickleburgh Road, Pug Street, A140, Diss Road, Victoria Road, Park Road, Denmark Street, Shelfanger Road, Sunnyside, Heywood Road, Durbidges Hill, Crown Green (Diss, Heywood, Dickleburgh and Rushall, Scole, Burston and Shimpling).

NB – This closure will be in place in two phases taking place between 23:00 and 06:00. The first taking place 11<sup>th</sup>-13<sup>th</sup> January, the second taking place 18<sup>th</sup>-20<sup>th</sup> January.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Road where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2025 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.


Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
